The Truth About Indoor Air Quality (IAQ)

Why is indoor air quality important?

Indoor air quality is a major concern to businesses, building managers, tenants and owners because it can impact the health, comfort, well being, and productivity of building occupants.

A fair number of Canadians spend up to 90% of their time indoors and many spend most of their working hours in an office environment. Pollutants in our indoor environment can increase the risk of illness such as Sick Building Syndrome (SBS) and

What you can do to improve the indoor air in your building/office:

- Do not block air vents or grilles.
- Comply with the office and building smoking policy.
- Water and maintain office plants properly.
- Dispose of garbage promptly and properly.
- Store food properly.
- Avoid bringing products into the building that could release harmful or bothersome odors or contaminants.
- Notify your building or facility manager immediately if you suspect an indoor air quality problem.

Controlling indoor air quality involves integrating three main strategies. First, manage the sources of pollutants either by removing them from the building or isolating them from people through physical barriers, air pressure relationships, or by controlling the timing of their use. Second, dilute pollutants and remove them from the building through ventilation. Third, use filtration to clean the air of pollutants.
